## OPEN FIRE BAN AND CAMPFIRE REGULATIONS

## Thank you for following the campfire regulations!

Open fires are not permitted in the City. No grass, garbage or yard waste burning in city limits.

Burning is limited to Campfires subject to the following:

- Campfires may not be larger than 0.5 meters by 0.5 meters
- Campfire fuel limited to charcoal briquettes or dry seasoned firewood
- You must have a firebreak of at least 1 meter around the fire and maintain this break throughout the time the fire is burning
- You must have at least 8 litres of water within 2 meters of the fire
- The campfire must be attended at all times
- The campfire must be extinguished before you leave

It is also important that if you chose to have a campfire, you check the BC Wildfire Website for campfire bans or open fire restrictions!
